Students will learn about the naming parts of a sentence, which is also known as the subject of a sentence.

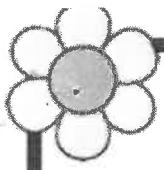
Sight Words

Science

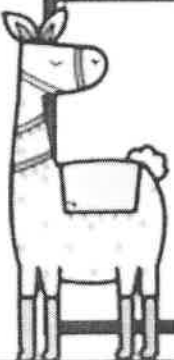
Students will finish up learning about pumpkins. The test will be ONLINE through Canvas. If your child doesn't do it online, he/she will complete it during recess.
