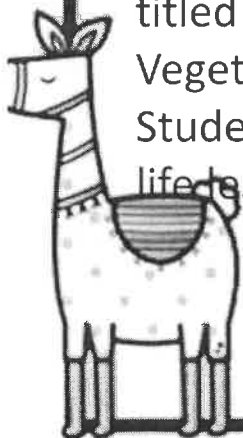
WEEK OF: 3/22-3/26

Grammar

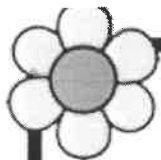
Students will continue to use adjectives. This week they will be describing how many.
