## Reading

Students will work on describing words using the -er and -est.

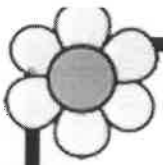
For example: tall, taller, tallest

## Science

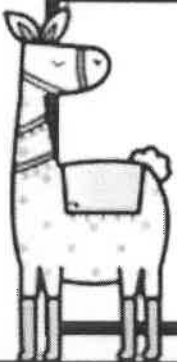
Students will not have a science unit this week.
