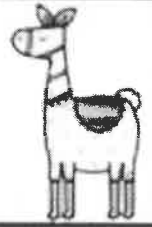

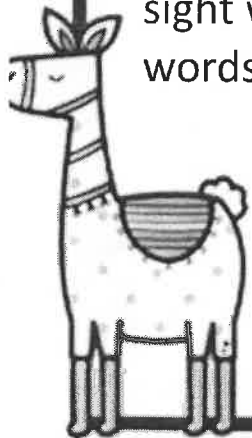
WEEK OF: 4/26-4/30

Grammar

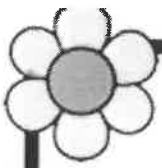
Students will work more on verbs this week. Specifically, students will tell about verbs that tell about now, or present.

Science

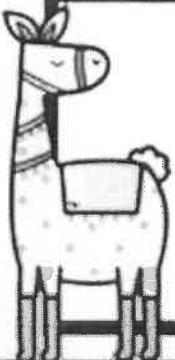
Students will learn about pollutions and the 3R's (reduce, reuse, recycle). Students will learn about the importance in taking care of Earth.
