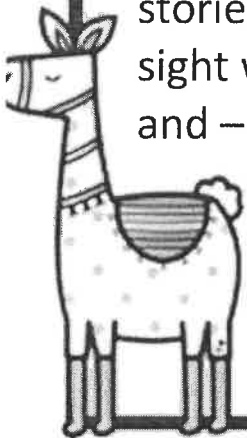
**WEEK OF:** 5/3-5/7

## Grammar

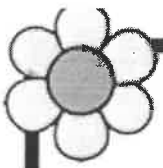
Students will learn when to use am, is, and are appropriately when writing sentences.
