## Language Arts

### Reading:

We will focus on Story Structure next week as well as asking and answering questions. Students will bring home their reading book next week. Please talk with your child about how to take proper care of his/her book. In addition, every day your child is in school, please send the reading book with them. We will be using it in class.

We will focus on two stories next week. "My First Day" is a realistic fiction, where students will focus on key events in the beginning, middle, and end of the story. "Try This" is a narrative-fiction, where students will ask and answer questions throughout the text. Below you will see high-frequency words we will cover throughout the week.

### Spelling:

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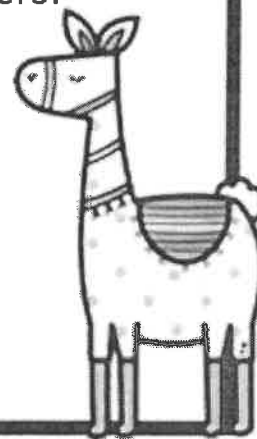
### Upcoming Events
